DESCRIPTION

STADIO Higher Education offers a unique online bridging programme to equip and support students who would like to enroll for a master's programme.

This bridging programme is aimed at prospective students with a qualification on NQF-level 8 but with inadequate credits for research design and methodology in their NQF-level 8 qualifications. It is also available to prospective students who need a refresher course before entering the master's qualification.

Successful candidates will be considered for admission to master's degree studies, although this is not guaranteed.

The course is presented by a highly experienced academic, supervisor and researcher, Professor Flip Schutte. Weekly online lectures will be presented.

PROGRAMME OUTCOMES

- Outcome: Research report of limited scope
- Certification: Students who successfully complete the course will receive a Certificate of Competence
- Admission to a master's degree at STADIO: Successful candidates may gain admission to a master's degree at STADIO, subject to normal terms and conditions.
