TIME FRAME: 3 HOURS | MODE OF DELIVERY: ONLINE & SELF-DIRECTED

MODE OF DELIVERY

The programme is presented online and is designed to be completed in the participants' own time over two weeks, with a commitment of approximately three hours in total, or 15 minutes daily. The course is completely asynchronous, and students can work through the content in their own time.

PROGRAMME PURPOSE

This short learning programme is designed to assist graduates, from various creative disciplines to curate their first portfolio, whether the purpose of the portfolio is to secure employment or develop a coherent body of work that showcases their skills and attributes. Using design thinking steps as a framework, the graduate will be guided through the process, from concept to implementation.

PROGRAMME OUTCOMES

On completion of this short learning programme, you will be able to:

- 1. Recognise the purpose and value of your portfolio as a tool to secure employment.
- 2. Investigate various approaches to plan a portfolio for the purpose of showcasing your skills.
- 3. Recognise the value of prototyping in the creative approach.
- 4. Implement different strategies to evaluate your portfolio and manage feedback.
- 5. Recognise your portfolio as a living document composed of numerous iterative processes.
